


Steve D. Parker

PRIOR PROFESSIONAL HISTORY

Mr. Parker served as a pilot in the U.S. Navy from 1987 to 1995. He flew the T-34, T-2, TA-4, and the single seat fighter and attack F/A-18 aircraft. He was an F/A-18 Fleet Pilot with VFA-132 aboard the USS Forrestal Aircraft Carrier.

During a cruise to the Mediterranean Sea, he flew Operation Provide Comfort missions in the Northern No Fly Zone over Iraq. In May of 1992, he reported to VFA-106 in Jacksonville, Florida for duty as an F/A-18 Instructor Pilot.

He specialized in Air-to-Ground training and instructed Navy pilots to fly in the low altitude flight regime. He also taught formation-flying, aircraft interception, air combat maneuvering, and in-flight refueling.
